A Singapore based company focusing on providing high speed internet to the 40 million people of the Pacific region, including Vanuatu. To achieve the connectively and ultimately in terms of becoming more efficient, competitive and profitable.

Covid-19 & TC Harold

Due to the spread of the COVID-19, lots of projects needed to be postponed or cancelled. In addition to that, Tropical Cyclone Harold was considered a powerful tropical cyclone which caused widespread destruction in Vanuatu. COVID-19 preparedness activities were suspended to facilitate preparations and evacuations for TC Harold. Travel and social distancing restrictions associated with the COVID-19 pandemic were lifted for those seeking safe houses and evacuation shelters. Hundreds of people evacuated to shelters in Espiritu Santo and disrupted communications in rural areas made estimates difficult for many people.TC Harold was the first Category 5 severe tropical cyclone to strike Vanuatu since Cyclone Pam in 2015.

Vanuatu is rapidly approaching an economic crisis that could bring about a prolonged humanitarian crisis on an unprecedented scale. Employment opportunity faces a downfall and many business were affected by COVID 19. Vanuatu Government has acted impressively throughout these challenging times. By quickly closing borders and dealing with TC Harold response and come up with additional resources for future recovery.



"I am trying to run the business and coordinate jobs remotely and I had to rely on using contractors to do the jobs that I would have otherwise done. Everything from transport, communication to Labour is more expensive and I find that I have been put in the situation of investing a lot more in my business than I was planning to at this point "Dragos Mihaila. Pacific Link Limited had to satisfy its customer needs by providing additional resources right after TC Harold.



Luckily, the business infrastructure was not actually damaged at all, but the plants & trees around the farm are very much down. It will take a year for plants to recover and there is a lot of clean up to deal with.
